▶ \$76,611 in grants supported classroom innovations, technology and programs

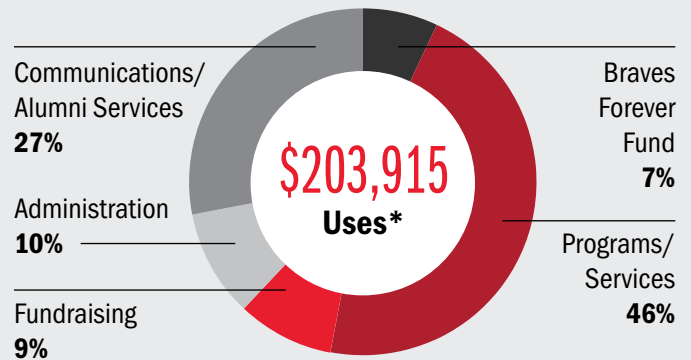
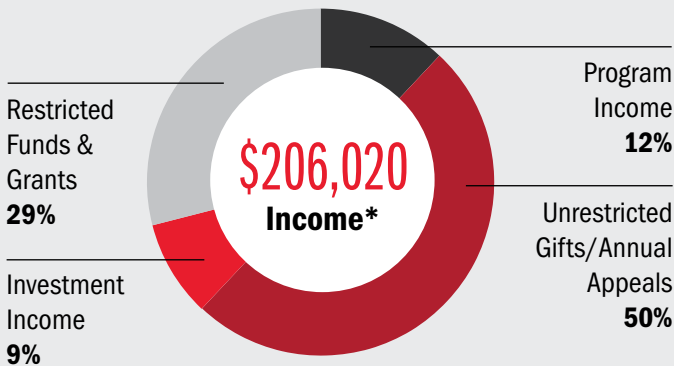
