

ENGRAVED PAVER AND DONOR WALL FREQUENTLY ASKED <u>QUESTIONS</u>

Q: How do I purchase a paver?

You can purchase a paver online or by completing an order form and mailing it to: Indian Hill Foundation 6855 Drake Rd. Cincinnati, OH 45243

Q: How do I pay for my paver?

You may pay for your paver with a credit card or check. For donations over \$500, you can make a donation pledge payable over 2 or 3 years.

Q: How long will pavers be available?

There are a limited number of pavers available. The Indian Hill Foundation will accept orders while supplies last.

Q: Can I purchase a paver with a group of people?

Yes! You can purchase a paver as a group gift. Please email <u>Debbie.ericsson@indianhillschools.org</u> for additional information on how to complete a group paver purchase.

Q: When and where will my paver be installed?

Pavers will be installed in the new Home of the Braves Welcome Plaza in random order. The exact date of installation is dependent upon the construction timeline but installation is projected to occur during the 2019-2020 school year.

Q: Are there any restrictions on what I can inscribe on my paver?

There are no specific restrictions but each inscription is subject to approval by the Indian Hill Exempted Village School District Board of Education.

Q: How do I change my inscription?

The IH Foundation will contact you to confirm your inscription prior to engraving. During this time, you will be able to change your inscription. Revisions may not exceed the character limit of the purchased paver.

Q: Will I get to keep my paver?

The paver will be installed in the Home of the Braves Welcome Plaza. It will add to the beauty of the plaza and become part of the history of the Indian Hill School District. Your paver will commemorate your support.

Q: What happens if my paver gets damaged?

The Indian Hill Foundation is not responsible for wear and tear of the pavers.

Q: How do I get a plaque on the Donor wall?

Donations of \$5,000 and more will be recognized on the Donor Wall.

Q: What are the giving levels being recognized on the Donor Wall?

The Shawnee Family recognizes gifts of \$250,000 and above The Miami Family recognizes gifts of \$100,000-\$249,999 The Iroquois Family recognizes gifts of \$50,000-\$99,999 The Algonquin Family recognizes gifts of \$25,000-\$49,999 The Chippewa Family recognizes gifts of \$5,000-\$24,999



Q: What material are plaques on the Donor Wall?

The plaques will be made of bronze material.
