Parents, please remember that our annual registration and form completion can be found within [Final Forms](#). Please login and create an account at your earliest convenience, if needed, and complete the process. Additionally, as in years past, both students and parents will need to electronically sign-off that they have reviewed the 2020-2021 Student Handbook.

Since moving to an online fee system, students' school fees can be viewed and paid through EZPay. If you prefer to pay with a check, make it payable to 'Indian Hill High School.' School fees need to be posted by September 20th. Please plan to complete full payment no later than September 30th.

Only Juniors and Seniors will be invited to buy a parking permit for the first two weeks of school. Sophomores may begin buying permits during the third week of school. Students **MUST** have a parking permit to be able to drive to school. Parking information and forms can be found using the link above and were mailed home with these students this past spring.
