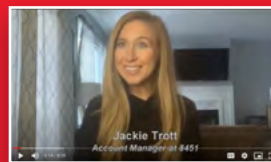

▶ Inaugural graduation celebration at Home of the Braves! From games to graduation, community was welcomed into fully finished facility.



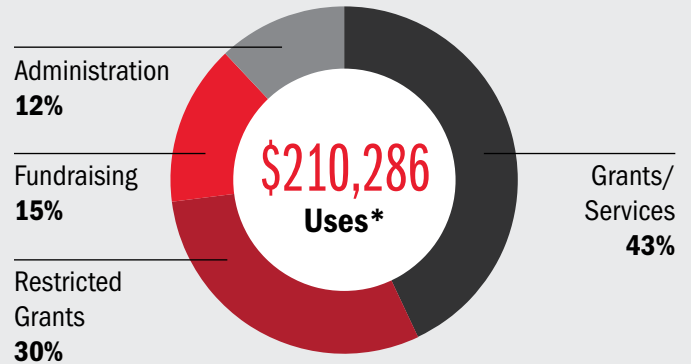
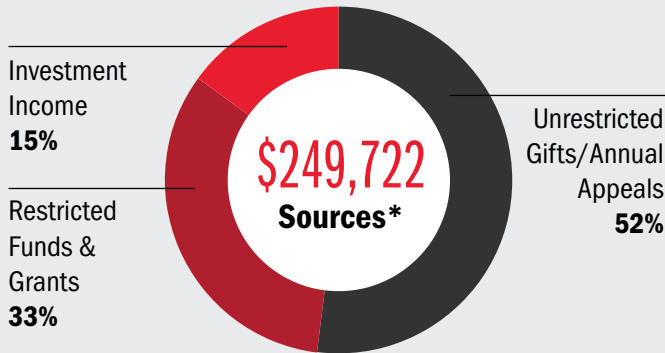
