Special Meeting of March 2, 2020

Chris Patek and Bill Baker of MSA Architects shared the revised facilities plan and new timeline. They discussed the next phase and breakdown of facility costs, using the different options for the basis of discussion. A dialogue was started between Board members and the consultants. Mr. Davis provided further clarification on the millage amounts. The Board discussed the need for a future meeting to discuss the bond/operation levy.

Tom Butt stated he had a discussion with Tom Wiedman, Sycamore Township Trustee, and he stated that the township will not be discussing future TIFs. He wanted to know why the Board wouldn't look at other options and adjust option C.

Laurie Sharrock – She wanted to know the new square footage amount of a new middle school. Chris Patek answered that it was approximately 110,000 square feet and approximately \$280/square foot. Mrs. Sharrock wanted to know how that compared with other districts. She wanted to know if there were line items for the general numbers presented. Mr. Patek responded that over the last two years the District has put together assessments and created a summary of each category.
