- A movement of more than 60 million girls and women, 110 years strong.
- A safe space for girls to discover their abilities, connect with others, and take action to create real change in the world.
- A proven, one-of-a-kind leadership experience.

The leadership skills and experiences girls gain through Girl Scouts help them succeed at school.

- Girl Scout participation positively influences girl leadership.
- Girls who experience solving problems and seeking challenges in Girl Scouting are more successful in school than girls who gain less experience in these areas.
- Girl-led and cooperative learning experiences promote Girl Scout outcomes that influence academic success, including higher grades and test scores than girls who do not participate.

of Brownie Girl Scouts (grades 2-3) like to work with others when they do a project.

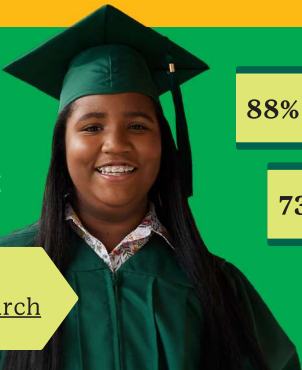
71%
