

Additionally, operational research during beginning phases of construction and community engagement this school year revealed the need to increase the scope of the project. Below you will find line-item details for each approved project:

- New IHES parking lot constructed (Summer 2023)


Indian Hill Middle School -Indian Hill High School Connector




- Auditorium main entrances and the athletic entrance closed

SAFETY FIRST

New Safety Measures

Enhanced safety measures at each school entrance have been designed using guidance from the Indian Hill Rangers and other professional school safety consultants. Some common features in our updated entrances include: locked vestibules, two-phase security entrances, and improved line of sight from offices to doors. We have an advanced security camera system throughout our campus that allows us to monitor students, staff, and visitors at all times. This security camera system also can be accessed remotely by school officials and the Indian Hill Rangers.

New Transportation App

This spring, our Transportation
Department deployed a new
app called "Stopfinder" for our
Indian Hill Primary School and
Indian Hill Elementary School
students. This allows families
to check each student's bus
schedule, bus number, and driver
name. Parents/guardians can
also receive alerts for real-time
information on their child's bus
location and receive
notifications when a
bus is delayed.

Staff and Visitor Badges

Improved identification practices enable staff to track and easily identify visitors in the buildings. All adults in our buildings, including staff, visitors, and contractors, must wear a visible ID badge. A newly integrated school safety software creates custom ID badges and allows us to screen and track visitors while they are in our schools.

Indian Hill School District Makes Significant K-12 Indoor Air Quality Improvements



The Indian Hill School District is leading the way in K-12 indoor air quality by equipping its classrooms with state-of-the-art air purification technology provided by Protect|ED, a leading supplier of innovative air quality products.

The partnership will support the district in its continued efforts to combat viruses and keep children and teachers healthy and in school. The district, which serves nearly 2,200 scholars, is installing 143 units.

The portable WellAir Protect 900W with NanoStrike™ Technology incorporates patented technology that kills airborne micro-organisms and provides the first line of protection against viruses and bacteria such as COVID-19, influenza, and more. Rooted in science, NanoStrike™ Technology has been embraced by the medical community for the past decade and is used by institutions such as the Mayo Clinic and the Cleveland Clinic. 
