- Prioritize capital needs throughout the District (June 4)

- Collaborate with Finance Committee to identify funding options (June/August)
- Collaborate with Finance Committee to refine & prioritize District capital needs (August/September)
- Present District capital improvement scenarios to Board of Education (September/October)
