

How to Get the Transcript of YouTube Videos on Desktop

Step 1: Go to YouTube and find the video you want to obtain a transcript from by searching or going to the user's channel.

Step 2: Click 'More' ('...') under the video description.

Step 3: Click to open the transcript window.

Step 4: You will then see the YouTube transcript generator show up on the right side of the video. Click on any timestamp to skip to that part of the video.

Step 5: Click the down arrow next to the language at the bottom. You can then translate the transcript into any available language.

How to Get the Transcript of YouTube Videos on Mobile

Step 1: Pull up the video you want the transcript of on the YouTube app.

Step 2: Click on the arrow next to the description to bring up the video details.

Step 3: Scroll down and click 'Show Transcript.'

Step 4: You will then see the transcript pop up under the video. Clicking any of the timestamps will jump to that part of the video.

Step 5: Tap 'More' ('...') to select from the available languages to translate your transcript.

FAQ

Can I Download the YouTube Transcript?

Yes, click 'Show Transcript' under the video's description. Copy the text from the transcript and paste it wherever you need to download it. It will appear as text just like in any other word document.

Are There Any Other Ways to Get YouTube Transcripts?

Not every YouTube video has a 'Show Transcript' button. With these types of videos, you'll have to use other options. Another option to get the transcript of a YouTube video is to use the Notta Chrome extension. The extension transcribes any YouTube video in real-time. Then you can export into many file types, including:

- TXT
- DOCX
- PDF
- RTF
- and more

How Do I Copy a YouTube Transcript to Word?

To copy and paste the transcript of a YouTube video into Word, follow these steps:

- 1. Highlight the text in the transcript that you'd like to copy.
- 2. Press Control+C (Windows) or Command+C (Mac) to copy the text.

3. Go into Microsoft Word and press Control+V (Windows) or Command+V (Mac) to paste into the document. Select 'Plain Text' to make the text available for formatting.
