Grades 9 – 12 Womens Chorus

- Standard: Historical, Cultural and Social Contexts
 - Benchmark Identify music forms from various cultures and historical periods and create or perform representative repertoire with stylistic accuracy.
 - Indicator Compare various music styles from the United States, other cultures and historical periods.
 - Indicator Recognize and classify Western music literature by historical periods.
 - Indicator Discuss and perform music literature from various composers.
- Standard: Creative Expression and Communication
 - Benchmark Sing and/or play, independently or in ensembles, demonstrating technical and stylistic
 accuracy and musical expressiveness with appropriate responses to a leader's cues and gestures.
 - Indicator Sing or play, alone and/or in ensembles, a varied repertoire of music representing diverse genres and cultures.
 - Indicator Demonstrate technical accuracy, appropriate tone quality, articulation and expression for the work being performed with good posture and breath control.
 - Indicator Respond appropriately to the cues of a conductor or section leader.
 - Indicator Demonstrate ensemble skills (e.g., balance, intonation, rhythmic unity, phrasing) while performing as part of a group.
 - Indicator Demonstrate sight-reading abilities.
 - Benchmark Read, perform or compose music repertoire using a variety of tonalities while demonstrating an understanding of the language of music.
 - Indicator Improvise over given chord progressions and symbols.
 - Indicator Read, perform and/or notate a one-octave chromatic scale, ascending and descending.
 - Indicator Read and perform music with dotted eighth and sixteenth notes and syncopation in duple, triple and compound meters.
 - Indicator Define vocabulary in all rehearsed and performed music.

- Standard: Analyzing and Responding
 - Benchmark Analyze and evaluate music selections based upon established criteria.
 - Indicator Analyze conducting patterns and gestures as they relate to music selections.
 - Indicator Analyze and determine the correct technique (e.g., posture, breath support, hand position, embouchure, vocal placement) required for proper tone production.
 - Indicator Describe basic terminology and symbols used in a varied repertoire of music.
 - Benchmark Analyze and respond to conducting patterns and gestures in relation to interpretation of music performance literature.
 - Indicator Analyze how conducting patterns and gestures guide musical interpretation of selected pieces.
 - Benchmark Analyze common harmonic progressions in selected repertoire aurally.
 - Indicator Identify traditional harmonic progressions (e.g., I-V-I) in selected repertoire aurally.
 - o Benchmark Apply appropriate, established criteria to evaluate a variety of music performances.
 - Indicator Develop and apply criteria for evaluating quality and effectiveness of their performances and compositions and those of others.

 - o Benchmark Articulate similarities and differences between music and other content areas.
 - Indicator Identify art forms that involve collaboration with multiple art forms (e.g., musical theater, opera).
