APPOINTMENT OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PRINCIPAL - Dr. Knudson reported on the recent national search for an elementary school principal. Approximately 35 applicants responded to our announcement of the position. Fifteen applicants were screened and five of those sent to an Interview Committee comprised of faculty, staff, administration, parents and students. The Interview Committee met over two days to interview the five candidates; their reflections were sent to the Superintendent for consideration. Dr. Knudson indicated that while several very capable candidates applied for the position, Mrs. Melissa Stewart stood out as the best person to serve as the next Principal of Indian Hill Elementary School. Mrs. Stewart's experiences as a special education teacher, supervisor, and building administrator will serve the District well as she takes over the leadership of the Elementary School. Her talent for collaboration and coaching enables success for teachers and students. Dr. Knudson recommended a one-year contract for Mrs. Stewart to serve as Principal for the 2007-08 school year.
